Appendix II

Proposal #5: Allow a jv relay team to compete in the varsity relay race.

Southern League Standard Operating Procedures

200.4.4 **Separate Relay Races:** Southern League will have separate varsity and JV relay races unless the TD decides the races should be run jointly.

200.4.4.1 A coach is allowed to put a varsity team in a JV relay race. ~~but cannot put a JV team in a varsity relay race.~~

200.4.4.2 A coach is allowed to put a JV team in a League's varsity relay race only if the school's team is comprised of 10 or more racers of one gender.

Outcome of vote: Proposal #5 was unanimously denied.
